









The Safe Streets for All (SS4A) Action Plan is a community-driven initiative led by the Regional Transportation Commission of Southern Nevada and local government partners to reduce traffic deaths and serious injuries across our region.



Southern Nevada has seen an alarming rise in crashes and deaths for people who walk, bicycle, and ride motorcycles. On average, 226 people die in crashes every year in Southern Nevada— that's nearly one death every 1.5 days.



Through community input and data analysis, the plan will identify and build solutions to make roadways safer for everyone.



You can get involved by participating in surveys, focus groups, and community walk audits. Later this year, help us assess the effectiveness of temporary demonstration safety projects in your neighborhoods.
